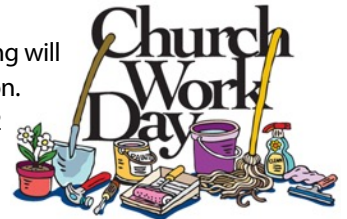
Women's Spring Event: Saturday, April 21 at 10:00 a.m. in the Family Room. Bring a brunch or lunch item to share.
